He is active in community volunteer work with such organizations as the Sasha Bella Fund For Family Centred Care through the Hospital For Sick Children, Lilah's Fund, which raises funds for study and treatment of neuroblastoma, the Multiple Sclerosis Society of Canada, and Blooming Acres, a specialty camp for children with Tourette's syndrome, Down syndrome, autism and other physical and mental challenges, of which he is also a Board member.
